RE: Upcoming Advisory Panel Meeting to Develop FPRs

The Summer Flounder, Scup, and Black Sea Bass Advisory Panels will be meeting on Sept, 10, 2013 to develop Fisheries Performance Reports (FPRs) with the Summer Flounder, Scup, and Black Sea Bass Advisory Panels from the Mid-Atlantic Fisheries Management Council (Council). FPRs will be developed for use by the SSC, Council, and Commission when developing quotas and specifications for the 2014 fishing year. The FPRs will provide input on factors that have influenced catch levels over time and could include the following topics: market issues, environment issues, management issues, management induced effort shifts, fishing behavior issues, or general fishing trends. Prior to creating the FPR the staff will present a fisheries information document that summarizes the assessment, basic biology, and catch, landings, and other fishery and market info to the AP (this document will be sent to the AP a week prior to the meeting).
