RE: 2024 Coastal Shark Specifications

This memorandum serves as notification of the results of the electronic ballot to set the 2024 specifications for the coastal shark fishery. As voted on by the Coastal Sharks Management Board, the following motion carries without objection:

Move to adopt the 2024 coastal shark specifications as specified in the National Marine Fisheries Service final rule for the 2024 Atlantic Shark Commercial Fishing Season published on November 18, 2023. The fishing season will open on January 1, 2024 with a commercial possession limit of 55 large coastal sharks (LCS) other than sandbar sharks per vessel per trip (i.e. aggregated LCS and hammerhead shark management groups) and 8 blacknose sharks per vessel trip. The commercial possession limit is subject to change; states will follow NMFS for inseason changes to the commercial possession limit.

This action complements the National Marine Fisheries Service's final rule for the 2022 Atlantic Shark Commercial Fishing Season, which can be found at: https://www.federalregister.gov/documents/2023/11/08/2023-24307/atlantic-highly-migratory-species-2024-atlantic-shark-commercial-fishing-year

The commercial fishing season will open on January 1, 2024. The commercial possession limit at the start of the season will be 55 large coastal sharks (LCS) other than sandbar sharks (i.e. aggregated LCS and hammerhead shark management groups) per vessel per trip. The commercial possession limit at the start of the season will be 8 blacknose sharks per vessel per trip. NMFS may consider in-season adjustments to the commercial possession limits depending on catch rates.
